The items below show the categories to be utilized to provide the minimum information to be provided for a nominee to be effectively considered. By following the guidelines and referring to the more detailed process published on the AMYA web site at <<http://theamya.org/hof/hallpolicy.php>>, any AMYA member may nominate individuals for consideration for induction into the Hall of Fame. All categories should be answered in as much detail as possible. Final approval of any nominee will be based on the information provided in responding to the items below. The review committee may not seek additional information on a nominee.

All materials provided to support a nomination shall become the property of the AMYA and will not be returned. Once a nominee selected for induction into the Hall of Fame, all material on that individual shall be transferred to the control of the Executive Secretary.

It is requested that nominations be submitted as an e-mail with attachments to facilitate distribution to the committee. Duplication of this form is not necessary; simply start with the name of the person to be nominated, who is the member submitting the nomination, and who is the member seconding the nomination. Include each person's AMYA Number and Club affiliation.

This nomination and the detailed support information it requires must be received by the AMYA Vice President no later than July 10 of the current nomination year, and will be presented to the committee on or about August 1.

Section 1: Personal History of the Nominee

- a. Name, address, city, state, zip code of nominee.
- b. Phone number and e-mail address of nominee.
- c. Nominee AMYA number.
- d. Year nominee became a member of AMYA.
- e. Is the nominee a member in good standing to the present (or until deceased). Ten years of membership required.
- f. List the offices held within the AMYA and the year(s) served.

Section 2: Qualifications

- a. Provide a summary of any and all clubs that the nominee has founded, served as commodore or other officer, and/or been a vital part of the club success.
- b. Describe the accomplishments of the Club(s) and what role the nominee had in adding to that success.
- c. If the nominee has been involved in boat design or construction, describe that involvement.
- d. Describe what the nominee has done to promote RC sailing within his local area, region, and nationally, with results of those efforts.
- e. Describe how the nominee has influenced individuals to take up the sport/hobby of RC sailing and/or how he/she has helped others to learn the art or better experience the joy of RC sailing.
- f. Describe any involvement that the nominee has had within his local community that has resulted in bettering that community.

Section 3: Miscellaneous Information about Nominee:

- a. Provide a summary of why you believe the nominee should be inducted into the AMYA Hall of Fame.
- b. Indicate those areas that should be considered by the committee that would make the nominee stand out from any other nominee.
